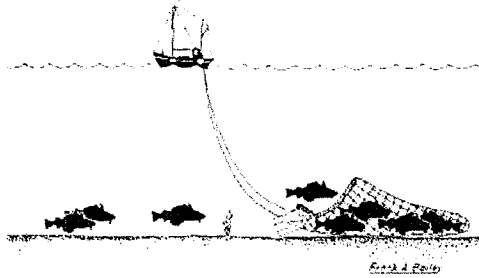
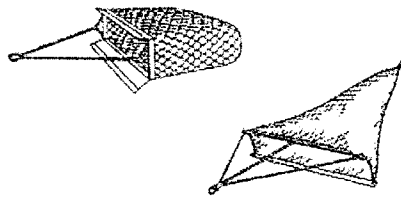


Netting Methods

Trawling: A trawl net is a type of fishing net that's pulled along the seafloor or at mid-ocean levels.



Dredges: Dredges are large, metal-framed baskets that are dragged across the seafloor. In order to lift the catch into the basket, metal teeth dig into the seafloor.



Gillnetting: Gillnetting uses curtains of netting that are suspended by a system of floats and weights; they can be anchored to the seafloor or allowed to float at the surface. The netting is almost invisible to fish, so they swim right into it.

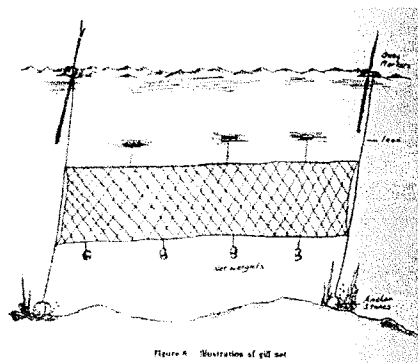


FIGURE 4. Illustration of gill net.
